#### Major Influence

#### Fleet Maintenance and Renewal

In 2013 Highway Purchased 4, F250 Pickup Trucks for \$98,750. Adding in two years of Maint. and Fuel cost against auction revenue of \$65,640 for the 4 units; applying the difference and dividing the total miles makes for an Average Cost per mile of \$0.37.

When looking back to 2009 using the same math gives us an average cost per mile of \$0.34, for 17 units.

Advantages: Vehicle is always under Warranty.

Employees are operating the safest, most efficient vehicles on the road.







#### Bridge Maintenance

Highway Division is beginning to reevaluate bridge maintenance working to create a more robust Bridge Maintenance Program Priority.

Program Enhancement began this year with two projects; Salmon Creek Road Bridge Deck Rehabilitation in Town of Lansing, and Brooktondale Road Box Culvert Replacement in the Town of Caroline.

#### Highway Communication Officer

With a small adjustment to Highway's FTE schedule we are able to bring our Administrative Assistant to a Full Time position, the added duties will include taking on a role as Highway Department Communication Officer. This role will include both external and internal communication. Department PIO representation, Website enhancement. The internal communication piece will include monthly department newsletter and project updates, response to Employee Climate Survey findings.



# Overall Pavement Quality





#### OTR #30 & #21

In 2006 Tompkins County Purchased 4 New 10 Wheel Dump Truck's equipped for Snow and Ice Control. All Four of these trucks are now due for replacement in 2016. This years OTR's (#30 and #21) request is for 2 units at a cost of \$235,000 per unit. This request brings our Equipment Replacement Schedule closer to balance.

OTR # 30 in the amount of \$46,000 augments the Target Balance for Equipment Purchase in order to Purchase a Second Unit.

OTR # 21 in the amount of \$235,000 is purposed for the purchase of a third Unit.
