Major Influences

- Nineteen programs and 105 staff served 6513 individuals in 2363 families in 2014
- 108 active collaborations and community partnerships
- 102 people with low incomes participated in non governance activities with support of TCAction
- 350 children received age appropriate health screenings and immunizations and participated in preschool activities preparing for school readiness, and 150 children and their families continue receiving support through 2nd grade with Primary School Support Program
- 114 households with low incomes received energy saving measures in their homes, saving on average, 25% of energy consumption
- Staff received 3419 hours of job relevant training
- Our recent Independent Audit indicates that 92% of all TCAction funding goes directly into program activities; we continue to be a low risk auditee
