Major Influences

- Cybersecurity training and funding is a priority. We are working in conjunction with ITS on next steps.
- Absentee voting is increasing at a high rate yearly. Costs for printing and staff hours are unpredictable.
- Aging voting machine warranties have expired. Funds are budgeted for repairs as we explore new voting equipment purchases in the future.
- Reduction of Senior Voting Machine Technicians from 35 to 20 hours per week in 2019 budget. We will need to increase hours in 2020 for Presidential General Election.
