- The change of \$59,660 reflects an extraction of \$50,000 originally set aside for a proposed relocation of OHR to the Human Services Annex in COFA.
- A one-time OTR of \$8,000 was designated for CNY Fair Housing, which partnered with OHR to provide education and outreach to County offices, housing providers, service providers and an annual public meeting on tenants rights
- Fringe and salary adjustments reflect the remaining \$1,660.

- Ongoing Education and Outreach Programs/Initiatives:
