  - Bail reform and associated consequences



### The Pendulum Has Swung to the Extreme



- Statements made by the D or co-D to a public servant or agent
- ► GJ transcripts for all witnesses
- Civilian witness names, adequate contact information, and designation as to whether they will testify for the prosecution
- LEO witness names, work affiliation, and designation as to whether they will testify for the prosecution
- Statements of witnesses.
- Expert witness names, work address, CV, publications, proficiency test results
- Tapes and electronic recordings; designation as to whether they will be introduced
- Photographs and drawings
- Photographs, photocopies, or reproductions of stolen property pre-release

Full documentation of forensic evidence analysis

All exculpatory material

Documentation and/or summaries of promises, rewards, inducements made to potential witnesses

List of all tangible property allegedly possessed by D or co-D; designation of type of possession

Search warrant applications, orders, and returns with inventories

Any tangible property related to the case; designation of which items the prosecutor will introduce

Records of judgment of conviction for all defendants and potential civilian prosecution witnesses

If known, the existence of any pending cases against potential civilian prosecution witnesses

For all VTL offenses, all records of instrumentation, calibration, certification, inspection, repair, and maintenance
