- 20 **<u>Report/Discussion: 2023 Tourism Program Budget</u> Wendy Kobler, STPB Budget Committee**
- 21 Wendy provided an overview of the proposed 2023 Tourism Program budget, which the members had
- 22 previously discussed in more detail at the May 2022 STPB meeting. Discussion covered various topics,
- 23 including stipends for grant review panelists, allocation by sector, managing budget overages, and more.

- Action: Wendy Kobler made a motion, which Ken Jupiter seconded, to recommend the 2023 Tourism
 Program budget. Motion carried by members present.

28 <u>Report/Discussion/Action: Recommend OTR for Arts & Culture Organizations</u>

- 29 Megan Barber presented two over target requests for arts and culture funding in the 2023 County budget:
- 30 the first was for \$117,000 for the ACOD grant program, and the second was for \$66,480 to assist

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- 31 Community Arts Partnership in supporting smaller local arts and culture organizations through regrants
- and other mechanisms. Megan's report and the accompanying group discussion covered a variety of
- topics. These included County procedures for consideration and approval of over target requests,
- 34 precedent setting, requested versus available funding, other pathways to funding arts besides tourism 35 dollars, matching funds through NYS Council of the Arts (NYSCA), possible next steps for STPB to take, and
- 36

more.

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Action: Steven Stull made a motion, which Greg Mezey seconded, to recommend an over target request of
 \$117,000 in the 2023 Tompkins County budget for the Arts and Culture Organizational Development grant
 program. Motion failed, 6-8. Doug Levine and Brett Bossard abstained.

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Action: Ken Jupiter moved, and Kelly Makosch seconded, to recommend an over target request for \$66,480
 in the 2023 County budget to supplement Community Arts Partnership's ability to provide funding support
 to local arts and culture organizations through NYSCA regrants and other mechanisms. Brett Bossard made
 a friendly amendment to increase the over target request to \$132,000. Motion carried.

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47 Update: Ithaca Downtown Conference Center – Tom Knipe, City of Ithaca

Tom introduced himself and shared a little about his background. He serves as economic development director for the City and used to head the County Tourism Program. His presentation provided an overview of project budget, financing, operations, and structure and detailed the various teams working to pull it all together. Q&A discussion covered various topics, including room tax projections, construction/capital budget, lease agreement, cost escalations, electrification of kitchen, contractors, and more. Suzanne Smith Jablonski, new executive director of the Local Development Corporation, introduced herself.
