- 30 Kelli provided an overview of the proposed 2023 Tourism Program budget. Her report and the
- 31 subsequent discussion covered budget committee deliberations, room tax revenue projections,
- 32 grant funding, room tax reserves, placemaking and wayfinding, and more topics. Budget
